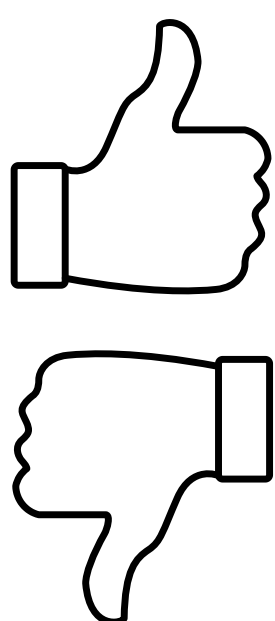

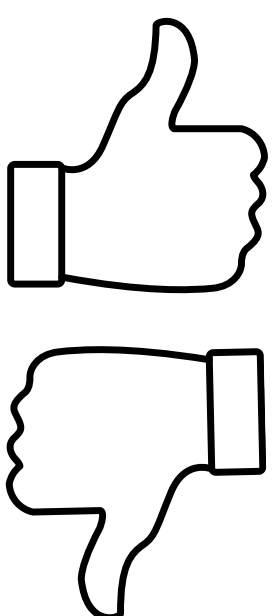

### Visiting Restrictions and Coping with Isolation | 10th November 2020
