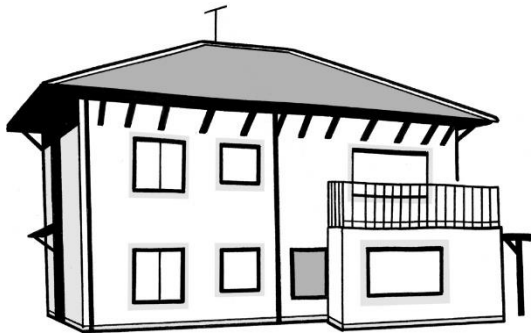

We told everyone about right2visit.info. It is an accessible website with information about visiting family and friends in care homes, supported living and ATUs.



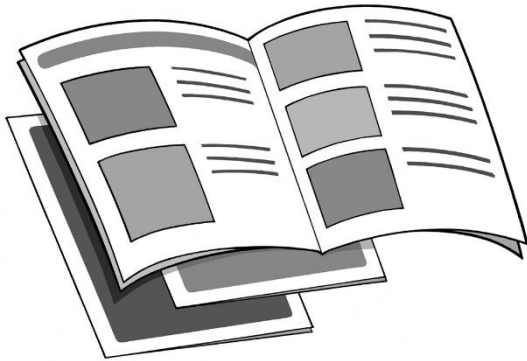
We also talked about visiting people in hospital.

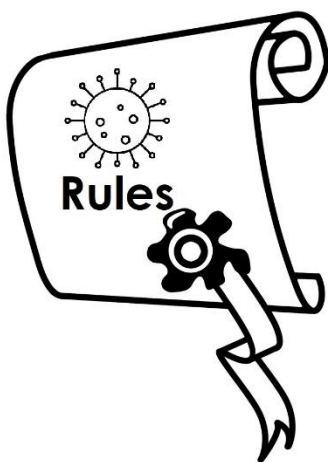
